

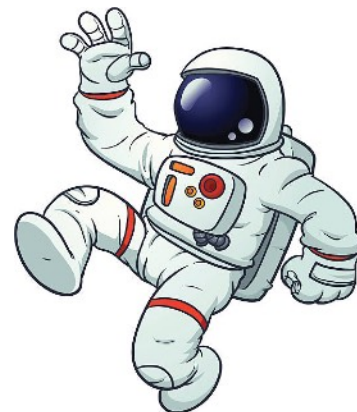
MOONWALKING RELAY

Materials Needed:

- 1 blindfold
- paper plates (other objects can work too)

How to play:

1. Give one person in your family a blindfold to wear. Have a non-blindfolded family member stand across the room.
2. Once the person is blindfolded, place "moon craters" around in an open area in your house (this can be the paper plates or other objects from around your house).
3. Family member who is blindfolded will try to walk to the other family member WITHOUT stepping on the moon craters. They will need the non-blindfolded person to help watch over them and give them verbal cues to direct their steps.
4. Once the blindfolded person make it to the non-blindfolded person, have them take off the blindfold and play again with someone else wearing the blindfold.



DISCUSS

After playing the game, DISCUSS as a family that the blindfolded person could not have made it across the space without the other person watching over them. Just like the non-blindfolded person watched over them and kept them from stepping on moon craters, God promises to watch over us!

ASK

Ask your kids ways that they know God watches over them.

REVIEW

Review today's need to know as a family: God promises to watch over me!
